Deposit Product Updates

As of December 1, 2012, two changes for new and existing accounts will take effect pertaining to certain deposit products at the Credit Union:

- Dividend rates for all share accounts* will now be based on the following tiered structure: \$0-\$50,000, \$50,000-\$100,000 and \$100,000+, with the rates ascending respectively.
- The early withdrawal penalty for new Savings Certificates and IRAs will now be structured as follows:

Term	Days' Interest Assessed
12 months or less	90
13-24 months	180
25-36 months	270
37-48 months	360
49-60 months	450

For all accounts, you have a grace period of ten (10) calendar days after maturity in which to withdraw funds in the account without being charged an early withdrawal penalty.

The Challenges of a Lengthy Retirement

Everyone hopes their retirement is healthy and happy and lasts as long as possible. The rapid pace of medical innovations plus healthier lifestyles have led to longer and healthier retirements than ever before. But a lengthy retirement is a double-edged sword that brings both rewards and challenges. Here are some of the issues you need to think about.

Social Security will pay you a monthly check as long as you live, but... not a very big check. Most everyone will need to supplement Social Security with withdrawals from their savings and investments.

Medicare health insurance kicks in at age 65, even if you claim Social Security early at age 62. Medicare is a good insurance program, but it does not cover everything.

Another factor is facing the possibility that you may not

be able to care for yourself at some point. Arranging for the care you may need in the future usually includes some long-term care insurance and/or planning.

To make sure you are prepared for both the opportunities and challenges of a long retirement, work with a financial advisor who understands the full impact.
