## For Your Protection . . .

We have been notified that there have been email fraud attempts known as 'Phishing" that were initiated via email to some Credit Union members. The false email entitled "Rewards Survey" appears to be from the National Credit Union Administration (NCUA) and encouraging recipients to complete a survey in exchange for a \$50 incentive.

If the recipient clicks on the link to participate in the survey, he or she is directed to a false website, where Credit Union account number and other personal information are requested.

Georgia Telco Credit Union does not ask members for such personal information. Anyone who receives an email that purports to be from Georgia Telco Credit Union and asks for account information should consider it to be a fraudulent attempt to obtain their personal account data for an illegal purpose and should not follow the instructions in the email.
